Plan now to attend our Good Friday Service on April 19th at 6:30 p.m. We plan to watch a documentary film on the persecuted church around the world.

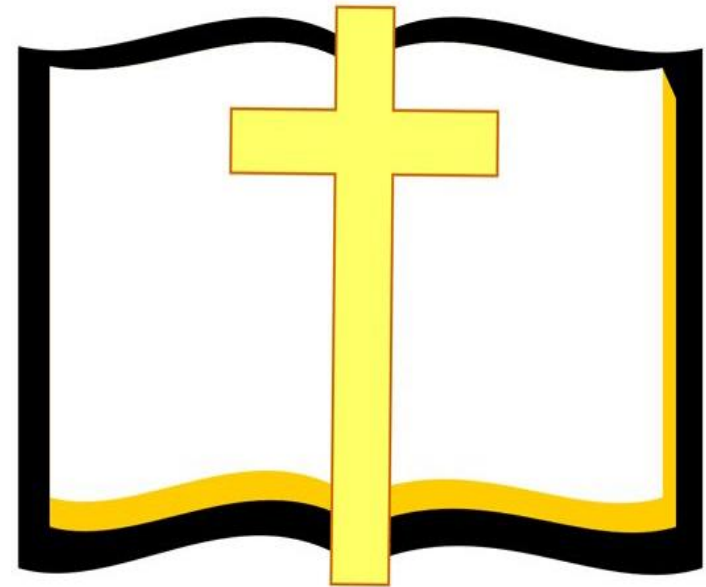
